Derecognition of KSOU courses: NHRC seeks reports from state, UGC

NEW DELHI: The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) on Thursday sought reports from the Karnataka government and the University Grants Commission over a decision to derecognise courses offered by the Karnataka State Open University (KSOU).

Intervening in the issue that could affect around nine lakh students, the NHRC asked the Karnataka Education Secretary and UGC officials to reply to its notice within four weeks about the issue involving the Mysuru-based KSOU. The action came on a public grievance letter received at the Commission which claimed that the future of these students is at stake due to the UGC decision.

In the letter, the NHRC said, it was argued that most of the poor students who could not afford to pursue courses from regular universities opted for distance learning programme offered by the KSOU. "They are in a dilemma, as to what

will happen if their courses are now derecognised," the letter said. The NHRC said there was "no clarification" from the university on the issue till date.

"About 40% candidates who have cleared an exam for the post of assistant professor, conducted by the Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA), are also uncertain about their future as to what will happen if the KEA, in line with UGC guidelines, de-recognises their degrees from KSOU, Mysuru," the NHRC said.

The Commission observed that it is an "unfortunate situation" for the students who despite having degrees from a duly recognised university are, in a way, being subjected to cruelty due to want of clarity in the matter. "It amounts to violation of their Right to Education and Equality as their future is at stake due to the proposed derecognition of some KSOU courses by the UGC after 2012-13," the Commission said.

10 VTU executive panel members suspended over irregularities

GOVERNOR Vajubhai Vala, who is also the chancellor of universities, has issued orders suspending ten members of the executive council of Visvesvarya Technological University (VTU), Belagavi late on Tuesday evening. The move follows notices issued to them recently.

According to sources in Raj Bhavan, the decision to withdraw the nominations of the 10 members was taken by the governor to facilitate their prosecution as they were allegedly party to each and every illegality and irregularities at VTU when Dr H Maheshappa was vice-chancellor.

"Before suspending the members, the governor issued them notices and sought explanation. Based on their explanations, the chancellor issued the suspension orders," explained a source.

In the notice seeking explanation, the governor had said, "Having received several complaints/allegations regarding irregularities and illegalities in the administration of VTU, Justice Keshavanaraya was appointed as the one-man fact-finding committee to enquire into the matter and submit the report.

"The report submitted by committee highlights certain irregularities in administration and functioning of VTU. The executive council is the body which needs to perform certain functions as required under Section 20 of VTU Act, 1994 to protect the interests of the university and the powers and functions are to be discharged without giving space for irregularities and illegalities.

"However, prima-facie, the irregularities and illegalities are attributable to the executive council also and members have failed to discharge their duties and functions and acted in a manner detrimental to the interests of the university."

A copy of the fact-finding committee report was also attached with the notices issued to the members.

According to information available, of the 10 members, two have submitted their resignations and one has approached the courts and the rest have submitted their explanations.

"One member has approached the court saying that he was not present at the council meeting when those decisions were taken. Two members submitted their resignations to the council as soon as they received the notices. But their resignations were not accepted as they are trying to get relief from prosecution procedures," a source said.

The governor has also communicated to the VTU, state government and University Grants Commission (UGC) to initiate similar action against the remaining executive council members, the source added.
